

PARENT RIGHT TO KNOW

The No Child Left Behind Act which is federal law allows parents to ask about the professional qualifications of their child's classroom teachers, and requires school systems to provide the information in a timely manner if they request it. Specifically, parents have the right to ask for information regarding teacher certification, college major and advanced degrees. Parents also have the right to request information about aides or paraprofessional personnel who provide services to their child.
